
What is the **UBO-register?**

The UBO-register includes those individuals who have control within legal entities (the ultimate beneficial owners or "UBO's"). The UBO-register will be part of the trade register of the Dutch Chamber of Commerce.

holds more than 25% of the shares or membership rights, or more than 25% of the voting rights



Both direct and indirect interest will need to be considered to determine the UBO. If no UBO can be determined, each managing director will be designated as pseudo UBO.



When?

The UBO-register enters into force on 27 September 2020. Newly incorporated entities must register their UBO('s) after that date. Existing entities have 18 months for the registration of their UBO('s).

Which legal entities?

All relevant legal entities in the Netherlands, for example: private limited liability companies, non-listed public limited liability companies, foundations, associations and limited partnerships must register certain information regarding their UBO('s) in the UBO-register.

Which Information?

Certain information of the UBO('s) will be publicly accessible: the name, the birth month and year, the nationality, the country of residence and the nature and size of the interest held.
